Cost: Up to a standard pickup load - \$15

Additional Cost: TVs/Monitors 19" and below - \$25, 20" – 27" - \$30, 27" and up - \$35

Computer towers – no charge

Scrap metal – no charge

Payment: **CASH ONLY**

A reminder about unlicensed/inoperable vehicles:

Excerpts from Grand Meadow Ordinances: 151.39 PARKING AND STORAGE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES: No motor vehicle or trailer without current license plates shall be parked or stored on any property in a residential district other than in a completely enclosed building. 92.20 INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES: It shall be unlawful to keep, park, store or abandon any motor vehicle which is not in operating condition, partially dismantled, used for repair of parts or as a source of repair or replacement parts for other vehicles, kept for scrapping, dismantling or salvage of any kind, or which is not properly licensed for operation with the state. This section does not apply to a motor vehicle enclosed in a building and/or kept out of view from any street, road or alley, and which does not foster complaint from a resident of the city. A privacy fence is permissible.

Dogs and cats – Must be registered and licensed with the city. Registration can be completed at City Hall during normal business hours. Cost is \$3.00 and proof of vaccination for rabies and distemper is required.

Pet feces – Owners are responsible for cleaning up feces on their own property, property of others and public property.

Golf carts – Permits are required to operate within city limits. Registration can be completed at City Hall during normal business hours. Cost is \$25.00 and proof of insurance is required.

Electronic water bills – If you would like to receive your bill by email, contact City Hall with your email address.

Online Payment – To pay online by credit card go to allpaid.com and use code 4940 to locate Grand Meadow. There is a fee depending on the bill amount associated with this service paid to allpaid.
